Instructions for connecting an audio source to an IPod, iPad or iPhone

In order to connect an audio source such as a wireless microphone, video recorder, PC or other audio device to an iPad for recording purposes you will need the following cables: CON01ADP (Conversor Adapter cable) – this is a 3.5mm 4-pin jack connector cable with a grey microphone socket and a black headset socket. Enables you to connect a microphone directly to the iOS device.



CON01IOS – this is a dual 3.5mm stereo jack plug which connects the audio device to the adapter cable. This cable is attenuated and ensures the correct amount of signal reaches the iOS device microphone socket.



Instructions for use

Before starting turn down the volume of the audio device. Plug the Conversor adapter cable into the iOS device using the 4-pin plug. Then plug the dual plug connector into the headphone or output socket of the audio device and into the grey socket on the adapter cable. Adjust the volume on the audio device and the iOS device to give a good signal strength and then start recording.
